

Gum abscess

Female, 44; presented with a gum abscess under upper right molar, accompanied by severe pain, inflamed throat, and tender cervical lymph nodes. She had consulted a dentist, who had lanced the abscess and prescribed amoxicillin, which she was unwilling to take.

Gum abscess

Treatment

EO *Thymus vulgaris* CT thymol (Thyme)

EO *Satureja montana* (Winter Savory)

EO *Eugenia caryophyllus* (Clove Bud)

EO *Cinnamomum zeylanicum* (Cinnamon Bark)

in a base of Labrafil : 25 drops in ¼ glass water –
gargle and swallow 5 times a day for 2 days, then 3
times a day for 5 days

Gum abscess

Outcome

The swelling and pain quite rapidly subsided, with a discharge of pus for three days. On the third day there was a flare-up, so dosage was again increased to five times a day. Within hours it had again subsided, with a definitive resolution of pain, swelling, and inflammation.
